Directions for Use

SDS must be read before opening the product.

TEST ON A SMALL INCONSPICUOUS AREA FIRST – check for colour stability and the desired result.

Prepare Surface Area

Sweep vacuum or wipe surface

Preparation of Solution

General Cleaning – 1 part to 15 parts water

Heavy Duty Cleaning – 1 part to 8 parts water

Method of use: Spread solution over the area carefully with a mop or a nylon pad. Allow to stand for 2-3 minutes. Agitate using a nylon scrubbing pad or a rotary scrubbing machine to help breakdown heavy soils or stains. Do let the solution dry. Apply more water to keep wet. Rinse with water or **Rodaux Neutral Bright** to fully neutralise and remove any residue. Repeat if necessary.

Precautions

- **Test First:** Due to the nature of different surfaces, always do a test first in an inconspicuous area to determine surface colour stability and desired results.
- Do not mix with any other chemicals.
- Wash thoroughly after handling.
